Re: Student Fee Advisory Committee Recommendation

The Associated Students conducted a student referendum to measure the student support of raising the Associated Students Fee by \$19 per year, from \$117 to \$136. The referendum was held April 17 through April 21. The proposed fee increase was approved by the required majority of students voting in the referendum as shown in the results below. At the May 4, 2023 meeting, the Student Fee Advisory Committee (SFAC) met and accepted the results from the student referendum. Based on the results of the referendum, the committee voted to recommend increasing the Associated Students Fee as proposed.

The results of the ballot question is as follows:
